



### General Election Results

The City of Westminster conducted a general election on May 9, 2017 for the position of Mayor and two members of the Common Council. The total number of votes cast was 1,008! The results were:

#### Mayor

Joe Dominick = 561  
Kevin Utz = 404

#### Common Council

Tony Chiavacci = 623  
Anne Thomas Gilbert = 531  
Benjamin Yingling = 619

### Westminster Fiber Network

The following is a status report on the construction of the Westminster Fiber Network, which got underway in 2013. The take rate is defined as the number of customers divided by possible customers. By signing an Access Agreement, residents are requesting a fiber optic drop to be brought to their location, positioning them for connection to the Westminster Fiber Network at a future date of their choosing.

Some highlights of the Westminster Fiber Network project:

- Pilot Phase became operational in September 2015; includes commercial areas near Carroll County Airport and residential areas near Carroll Lutheran Village; take rate is 29%;
- Phase One became operational in February 2017; includes northwest part of city—Bolton Hill, Cliveden Reach, Village of Meadow Creek, Stoneridge Overlook, and Whispering Meadows; take rate is 20% and 52% of residents have elected to have fiber drops installed; and
- Phase Two construction is underway; includes the area generally bounded by MD 140, MD 31, Bell Road, and Old New Windsor Road, Avondale Ridge, Avondale Run, Eagleview Estates, Fenby Farm, Furnace Hills, The Greens, and Wakefield Valley; 43% of residents have elected to have fiber drops installed.

### FY2018 Budget Adoption

Westminster property owners will pay the same real property tax rate as they have for the last four years, after the Mayor and Common Council approved the Fiscal Year 2018 budget on May 8, 2017.

Westminster's FY 2018 operating and capital budgets total \$74.46 million. Budget highlights include funding for:

- A \$5.0 million bond issue for an expanded street overlay program;
- A survey to gather residents' opinions across a range of community issues;
- Consulting services to advise and assist City staff in updating the City's Sign Code; and
- A Main Street Speaker Series to help local merchants identify their needs and provide speakers to address those needs.

The real property tax rate will remain at \$0.56 per \$100 of assessed valuation for FY 2018. Personal property tax rates will remain unchanged as well.

The adopted budget for FY 2018 continues the existing water and sewer rates. Rate studies will be performed during the fiscal year, which will provide the basis for establishing rates in FY 2019 and subsequent years.

### Pickup Schedule Key

- T** Tree limbs/Brush (no longer than 4 feet, no larger than 6 inches diameter)
- M** Metal, Tires, Batteries, Large Appliances (excluding dishwashers, TVs, microwaves)
- Y** Yard waste – brown paper bags or containers less than 50 lbs, bushel-size or smaller; no plastic bags, dirt or sod, concrete, rock or brick
- E** Bulk Trash East of MD Rt31 \*including Village of Meadow Creek, excluding Carroll Meadows
- W** Bulk Trash West of MD Rt31 \*including Carroll Meadows, excluding Village of Meadow Creek
- N** NO PICKUP, City offices closed for Holiday

**\*NOTE: If the scheduled pickup day falls on a City holiday, bulk trash items will be collected on the next scheduled date.**
