Questions Submitted by Bidders Attending:

1. Question: What existing building documents do you have for the Durbin House?

Answer: None, no plans or building documents exist.

2. Question: In the RFP on page 6, will the city give guidance to determine the use?

Answer: Not at this time, the goal of this study is to have a list of ideas that then can be executed in a planned approach as a part of the larger Master Plan for Wakefield Valley Park.

- 3. Question: Do you have a budget that can be shared for this project?

 Answer: No, we do not release that information. However, we do have grant funding secured for this project.
- 4. Question: Does the walk over include the entire grounds?

 Answer: No, just the Durbin House and corresponding property immediately around the house.
- 5. Question: Is cost estimation a part of the RFP?

 Answer: Yes, it is not clearly defined in the RFP, but it is certainly desirable information and helpful for future planning and budgeting.
- 6. Question: Do you have a format to follow for the RFP or table of contents?

 Answer: No, this is up to each prospective bidder.
- 7. Question: Should we use the bid form?
 Answer: Yes
- 8. Question: Is there supplemental funding to the grant?

 Answer: Yes, there is a match required.
- 9. Question: Will you share your ideas for the plan with the successful bidder?

Answer: Yes, it is an open book for planning, but we do have some ideas that will be shared with the successful bidder.

10. Question: How detailed of a phase planned are you looking at?

Answer: We are certainly not looking for extensive detail, but would like to know enough information to establish and prioritize future projects and initiatives.

- 11. Question: What kind of detail are you looking for in the cost estimate?

 Answer: Enough detail for creditable rough order magnitude.
- 12. Question: Is there a project timeline?

 Answer: Yes, however it is open-ended and will be discussed and mutually agreed upon once a firm is selected.
- 13. Question: Is there a formal date of completion?

 Answer: Not necessarily, however our grant money needs to be expended by 2022.
- 14. Question: Are we required to have an archeologist on the team?

 Answer: It is preferred, but not required.
