



MUNICIPAL ELECTION NOTICE

The City of Westminster will hold their 2023 General Election on Tuesday, May 9, 2023.

The following elected officials to be chosen: Three (3) Councilmembers each to serve a four-year term (expiring in 2027).

A Person seeking to run for office must be:

- A registered voter of the State of Maryland and the City of Westminster
- At least 21 years of age at the time of swearing-in for the Election
- A resident of the City of Westminster (must be for a minimum of one-year at the time of the swearing-in for the Election – May 15, 2023)

REQUIREMENT: Filing Fee \$25.00

A \$25.00, non-refundable filing fee is required upon filing your official candidate forms. The City of Westminster accepts most forms of payment (personal check, cashier's check, money order, debit card, credit card [American Express, Master Card, Visa and Discover] or cash. The City is unable to accept payments through any apps.

The deadline for candidates to file is Monday, April 10, 2023, at 4:30 p.m.

City residents may cast their ballot from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. at their designated polling place. Registered Westminster voters who reside on the west side of Maryland Route 31, vote at the Westminster Community Building at the Westminster Pool, located at 325 Royer Road. Registered Westminster voters who reside on the east side of Maryland 31, vote at the John Street Quarters of the Westminster Fire Company, located at 28 John Street.
