



MUNICIPAL ELECTION NOTICE

The City of Westminster will hold its 2025 General Election on **Tuesday, May 13, 2025** (the "Election.").

The elected officials to be chosen at the Election are for One (1) Mayor and Two (2) Common Councilmembers each to serve a four-year term (expiring in 2029).

REQUIREMENTS:

A person seeking to run for Office of Mayor must be:

- A qualified voter in City of Westminster elections;
- At least 25 years of age at the time of swearing-in for the Election; and
- A current resident of the City of Westminster and been a resident of the City for a minimum of two years

A person seeking to run for Office of the Common Council must be:

- A qualified voter in City of Westminster elections;
- At least 21 years of age at the time of swearing-in for the Election; and
- A current resident of the City of Westminster and been a resident of the City for a minimum of one year

A **\$25.00**, non-refundable filing fee is required upon filing your official candidate forms. The City of Westminster accepts most forms of payment (personal check, cashier's check, money order, debit card, credit card or cash). The City is unable to accept payments through any apps.

The deadline for candidates to file is Friday, March 21, 2025, at 4:30 p.m.

City residents may cast their ballot from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. at their designated polling place. Qualified Westminster voters who reside on the west side of Maryland Route 31, vote at the Westminster Community Building at the Westminster Pool, located at 325 Royer Road. Qualified Westminster voters who reside on the east side of Maryland 31, vote at the John Street Quarters of the Westminster Fire Company, located at 28 John Street.
